Notes:  
1) Uniform to be worn in winter. Winter  
Months are after ANZAC Day to 30th  
September.  
2) Flag officers to wear this uniform in  
winter. Optional for general Committee  
members. Refer to general committee  
winter uniform details for options.  
3) General Committee may wear Navy  
coloured Naval jumper in lieu of jacket.  
4) General Committee may wear this  
uniform with no jacket and no jumper.

# Mess Kit - Black Tie Uniform

Navy coloured epaulettes with rank.  
- Two Bars Rear Commodore  
- Three Bars Vice Commodore  
- Four Bars with Curl Current Commodore  
- Four Straight Bars Past Commodore

Name badge  
right lapel

Navy coloured Mess  
Jacket with gold chain.  
Chain length to be set to  
have jacket gap not  
exceeding 1 inch.

No Hat to be worn

2) Uniform to be worn to any other clubs

# Summer Uniform

White coloured epaulettes with rank.  
- Two Bars Rear Commodore  
- Three Bars Vice Commodore  
- Four Bars with Curl Current Commodore  
- Four Straight Bars Past Commodore

Name badge  
right lapel

Hat to be worn by Flag Officers when outdoors. Do not wear indoors. When attending other clubs a table will often be provided at the door to leave your hat whilst indoors. it is considered extremely poor form to pick up another officers hat.

White collared SYC shirt short sleeve.

White Belt and Gold Buckle

Flag Officers wear White Trousers.

White Shoes. Ideally to be leather dress shoes but may be smart white trainers without logos or other markings. For Opening Day events or other boating events white - non marking soled white trainers are preferable when boarding boats.

Notes:  
1) Uniform to be worn in summer. Summer Months are after 1st October to ANZAC Day, including ANZAC Day.  
2) Flag officers to wear this uniform in summer.  
3) General Committee members may wear black or navy shorts and black shoes instead with black belt and gold buckle.  
3) General Committee may wear Navy coloured Naval jumper in cold weather.  
4) Flag Officers may wear jacket and tie in cold weather.
