MONTHLY COMPETITION RULES

ELIGIBILITY

ANGLING MEMBERS MUST BE EITHER A FULL OR SOCIAL MEMBER OF SYC IN ORDER TO COMPETE.

ANGLING MEMBERSHIP IS \$100 PER ANNUM (\$50 for U14's). IF JOINING IN Q3/Q4 DISCOUNTED BY 50%. ONLY FINANCIAL MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR MONTHLY AND ANNUAL PRIZES.

NEW MEMBERS ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO PURCHASE AN ANGLING SHIRT AND CAP UPON APPLICATION.

SWAN YACHT CLUB ANGLING SECTION FISHES WITHIN THE RULES OF THE WESTERN AUSTRALIAN FISHERIES DEPARTMENT. NO NETS, TRAPS, SPEARS ARE ALLOWED. THE FIELD OFFICER HAS A FINAL SAY ON ANY RULINGS THAT MAY BE REQUIRED ON A FIELD DAY, EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF HIS/HER BOAT IN WHICH CASE THE NEXT MOST SENIOR COMMITTEE MEMBER MAY PASS RULING.

ALL BOATS MUST COMPLY WITH CURRENT DEPT. TRANSPORT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS.

FIELD DAYS (COMP)

MINIMUM ENTRANTS REQUIRED FOR A COMPETITION TO BE RECOGNISED – 3 BOATS.

6.00AM LINES IN ON THE NOMINATED START DAY; 3.00PM WEIGH-IN ON THE SUNDAY (4.00M IN SUMMER)

ALL COMPETITORS MUST <u>LOG ON</u> BEFORE GOING FISHING. <u>LOG ON SHALL NOT BE DONE BY SMS/ EMAIL/ WORD OF MOUTH – IT MUST BE VIA THE ANGLING WHATSAPP GROUP.</u> LOG ON MAY BE DONE THE DAY BEFORE SHOULD COMPETITORS BE LAUNCHING FROM A REMOTE LOCATION E.G. ROTTNEST.

THE WEIGH IN COMMENCES AT 3PM SHARP (4PM IN SUMMER) WHETHER ALL LOGGED-ON ANGLERS ARE PRESENT OR NOT AND WILL END WHEN THE LAST TEAM PRESENT HAVE WEIGH-IN. ANY TEAMS NOT PRESENT BY THE COMPLETION OF THE WEIGH-IN WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. THE WEIGH-IN STAFF MAY APPLY DISCRETION TO LATECOMERS DUE TO UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES.

ALL WEEKEND COMPS ALLOW ANGLERS TO FISH ONE OR BOTH DAYS AT THEIR DISCRETION. A TEAM/ BOAT MAY WEIGH IN THE BEST FISH CAUGHT ACROSS BOTH DAYS PROVIDED IT REMAINS WITHIN THE WA FISHERIES INDIVIDUAL CATCH/ BOAT/ POSSESSION LIMITS FOR ONE DAYS CATCH ONLY I.E AN ANGLER MAY HAVE CAUGHT 4 DEMERSALS OVER 2 DAYS (HAVING RETRUNED TO SHORE) BUT CAN ONLY WEIGH IN A MAXIMUM OF 2 (A SINGLE DAYS BAG LIMIT) BUT CAN CHOOSE THE 2 BEST FISH CAUGHT OVER THE 2 DAYS TO WEIGH IN. SIMILARLY, ALL NONDEMERSAL FISH MAY BE CAUGHT OVER THE 2 DAYS AND WEIGHED IN PROVIDED IT DOES NOT TOTAL MORE THAN A SINGLE DAYS BAG LIMIT.

THE DEFAULT ASSESSMENT FOR A COMP TO BE HELD IS "FISHABLE" WEATHER ON THE SUNDAY OF THE PLANNED WEEKEND. ON THE WEDNESDAY IMMEDIATELY PRIOR, THE FIELD OFFICER WILL MAKE A PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT ON THE WEATHER FOR THAT SUNDAY AND ADVISE ANGLERS ACCORDINGLY I.E. ON THE "PRIORITY" COMP WEEKEND, ONLY THE SUNDAY WEATHER IS USED IN THE ASSESSMENT AS TO WHETHER A COMP PROCEEDS. IN THE EVENT THAT THE WEATHER IS FISHABLE FOR BOTH SATURDAY AND SUNDAY, THE COMP MAY BE CALLED AS AN "ALL WEEKENDER" WITH ANGLERS PERMITTED TO FISH FROM 6AM SATURDAY TO 3PM SUNDAY.

ON THE FRIDAY EVENING PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION, THE FIELD OFFICER MAKE A FINAL ASSESSMENT OF THE WEATHER FORECAST. IN THE EVENT THAT THE WEATHER HAS CHANGED AND IS UNFISHABLE ON THE SUNDAY, THE COMPETITION WILL BE POSTPONED TO THE FOLLOWING "SECONDARY" WEEKEND WHERE EITHER SATURDAY OR SUNDAY OR BOTH MAY BE SELECTED DEPENDING ON THE WEATHER.

THE WEATHER FORECAST AND/ OR BOM WARNINGS SHALL ONLY APPLY TO THE TIMES APPLICABLE TO THE COMPETITION (6am-3pm). COMPS WILL NOT BE MOVED SOLELY DUE TO PREFERENTIAL WEATHER CONDITIONS.







AS A GUIDE ONLY THE DEFINITION OF "UNFISHABLE" IS ANY WINDS OVER 30 KNOTS OR SEAS OVER 3.0m AS AVAILABLE VIA PUBLISHED METEROLOGICAL DATA AND/ OR WEBSITES (SEEBREEZE, WILLYWEATHER, BOM ETC).

COMPETITION STRUCTURE

SYC ANGLING RUNS TWO PARALLEL COMPETITIONS AS FOLLOWS:

- i. TOP ANGLER- POINTS BASED
- ii. TOP BOAT- WEIGHT BASED

TOP ANGLER

ONLY ONE FISH OF EACH SPECIES CAN BE WEIGHED PER ANGLER AND WILL BE AWARDED POINTS AS FOLLOWS:

BOAT CATCH WEIGHTS

THE BOAT CATCH WEIGHT IS THE TOTAL WEIGHED IN FISH WEIGHT FOR THE BOAT DIVIDED BY THE NUMBER OF ELIGIBLE ANGLERS ON THAT BOAT. THIS NUMBER IS APPLIED TO CALCUALTE THE "TOP BOAT" CATEGORY AT THE END OF THE SEASON.

SKIPPERS WHO FISH AS CREW ON OTHER BOATS (DUE TO BOAT RENOVATIONS ETC.) CANNOT TRANSFER THEIR BOAT WEIGHT AS THEIR CATCH RELIES ON THE SKILLS OF THE SKIPPER ON THE DAY OF THE COMP.

SKIPPERS WHO <u>CAPTAIN</u> ANOTHER BOAT MAY HAVE THEIR BOAT WEIGHT APPLIED TO THEIR REGULAR VESSEL/ TEAM UNDER THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

- 1) THEIR BOAT BEING UNAVAILBLE E.G. USING THE CLUB BOAT
- 2) THE OWNER/ SKIPPER OF THE BORROWED BOAT BEING UNAVAILABLE
- 3) BY PRIOR ARRANGMENT ONLY
- 4) AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ANGLING COMMITTEE.

FISHING AREAS

THE COMPETITION AREA IS DEFINED AS PERTH MEOTROPOLITAN WATERS. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS COMPETITION, PERTH METRO WATERS IS DEFINED AS APPROXIMATELY:

- 1) BETWEEN TWO ROCKS MARINA AND MANDURAHG (DAWESVILLE CHANNEL)
- 2) ANYWHERE IN THE SWAN AND CANNING RIVERS
- 3) WEST OF FREMANTLE HARBOUR (NO LIMIT TO WESTERNMOST DEPTHS)
- 4) PROVIDED THAT BOATS ARE LAUNCHED WITHIN THESE AREAS, THERE IS NO LIMIT TO THE AREA THAT IS PERMITTED TO FISH I.E. LIMITED TO BOAT RANGE ONLY
- 5) FISH HABITAT PROTECTED AREAS WITHIN THIS ZONE ARE EXCLUDED. ANY BOAT CAIGHT FISHING IN PROTECTED AREAS WILL BE DISQUAIFLIED ALONG WITH ALL OF ITS ANGLERS.

SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

SHARKS MUST HAVE HEADS, FINS, TAIL AND GUTS REMOVED BEFORE BEING WEIGHED IN AND NO MORE THAN 10KGs CAN BE COUNTED TOWARDS BOAT WEIGHT MINIMUM LENGTH OF ANY SPECIES IS 200mm

EXCLUDED SPECIES

RAYS, PORT JACKSON AND WOBBEGONG SHARKS, EELS BLACK SINEFOOT, GURNARDS, SCORPIONFISH, FIREFISH, LIONFISH, STONEFISH, TOADFISH, PUFFERFISH, COWFISH, PORCUPINEFISH, SUNFISH, BOXFISH, ALL BUFFALO BREAM, ALL SHELLFISH AND CRUSTACEA, ROCK COD, SARGEANT BAKER, WESTERN BLUE DEVIL, WRASSE, BLUE & SCALY MACKEREL, YELLOWTAIL (Yakka's), TRUMPETER, PARROT FISH, KNIFE JAW, SCALY FINS, BUTTER FISH, BLACK DRUMMER, SWEEP, COBBLER, GOATFISH, LEATHERJACKET

OTHER SPECIES

NON-BONUS SPECIES CAN BE WEIGHED IN AND BE ELIGIBLE FOR 5 POINTS PROVIDED IT IS OF LEGAL SIZE AND SPECIES. HOWEVER, IF THE FISH CANNOT BE <u>POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED</u> BY THE ANGLER, THE FISH SHALL NOT BE WEIGHED IN. IT IS NOT THE RESPONSIBLITY OF THE FIELD DAY STAFF TO IDENTIFY FISH.

PRIZES

ONLY ONE PRIZE (INCLUDING PARTICIPATION/ MYSTERY FISH PRIZES) CAN BE WON BY ANY ONE ANGLER ON A COMP DAY. IN THE EVENT OF A POINTS DRAW THE ANGLER MEETING THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA (IN DESCENDING ORDER) SHALL PREVAIL:

- 1) MOST BONUS SPECIES
- 2) MOST BONUS SPECIES OVER BONUS WEIGHT
- 3) MOST NUMBER OF SEASON/ CLUB RECORDS (CLUB RECORD BEATS SEASON RECORD IN A TIE)
- 4) LARGEST INDIVIDUAL FISH WEIGHED IN (ANY SPECIES)







AWAY TRIPS

IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO JOIN THE AWAY TRIPS AN ANGLER MUST BE A FINANCIAL MEMBER

CLUB POINTS

CLUB POINTS ARE NO LONGER A REQUIREMENT OF SWAN YACHT CLUB.

WIND UP/ PRESENTATION NIGHT

IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PRIZES AT THE PRESENTATION NIGHT AN ANGLER MUST BE A FINANCIAL MEMBER
